Retailers Get First Viewing Of Grand Canal Shoppes At The Venetian Macao Resort Hotel

Preview day for over 200 Top Retail Chief Executive Officers

Macao, SAR, China (June 1, 2007) – Over 200 Chief Executive Officer’s representing top retail brands got their first glimpse of the spectacular Grand Canal Shoppes, in the heart of The Venetian Macao Resort Hotel®, today.

The senior retail executives participated in a special pre-opening VIP ‘Hard Hat’ tour, at which they were given a first opportunity to witness for themselves the unique Venice-inspired streetscapes and step through the cobbled walkways alongside the canals, arched bridges and piazza-style shopping streets.

Retailers understand that the combination of unique design and theming of the Grand Canal Shoppes, our Convention business, 15, 000 seat arena, 1,800 seat theatre for Cirque du Soliel, 3000 all-suite rooms and our other resort facilities will attract the customers that generate premium retail sales”.

The Grand Canal Shoppes will feature a dynamic mix of well-known brands across a wide variety of retail sectors including high-street fashion, footwear, jewelry and accessories, sports, and a cosmopolitan range of food and beverage offerings and nightlife. In addition, a number of international retail brands new to Asia have been secured.

Brands represented at the preview day included international retail names such as Versace, Mikimoto, Mont Blanc, Duty Free Americas, Swatch, Franck Muller, Chopard, Sub-Chrono, Boucheron and Piaget; and in the F&B sector representatives such as Cafe Deco, which is set to open a 1,000 seat restaurant its biggest outlet in Asia, and the world famous Buddha Bar.

Modeled on the famous European city of Venice, the one million square-foot Grand Canal Shoppes (GCS) will be the central attraction of The Venetian Macao, allowing visitors to experience the ornate architecture, canals and gondola rides of the Renaissance Italian city. The mall will feature a vast range of both international and local brand retail outlets, including some 20 leading food and beverage outlets, a 1,000-seat food court, an up-market nightclub and a 50,000-square-foot luxury spa.

The Venetian Macao will be one of the largest hotels in Asia and will be Macao’s first true mega-resort. It will feature 3,000 all-suite rooms, 1.2 million-square feet of meeting, convention and exhibition space, world-class entertainment in a 15,000-seat arena, and an impressive array of dining, shopping, and recreation options.

The Venetian Macao, located in Macao, Special Administrative Region of the People’s Republic of China, will also serve as the anchor of the Cotai Strip, a master planned development of resort and casino properties. The Cotai Strip™ will feature hotels operated by some of the most prestigious names in the hotel industry, including Four Seasons, Sheraton, St. Regis, Shangri-La, Traders, Hilton, Conrad, Fairmont, and Raffles. Las Vegas Sands Corp. will own and construct each of the hotels as well as operate the casinos and entertainment venues in each hotel.
