Manchester United Arrives in Macao in Anticipation of The Venetian Macao Cup

At the press conference in Macao today, Mr. Mark Brown and Mr. Manuel Silvério, Chairman of the Board of Directors MAIGOC; Mr. David Gill, Sir Alex Ferguson and members of the Manchester United FC; and members of the Shenzhen Xiangxue Eifiti football team to officiate at the opening of *The Venetian Macao Cup* event celebrations.

“We are very proud to introduce our new Venetian Arena,” said Mr. Brown. “Our facilities are designed to hold events of any and every type, which is part of our promise to bring great entertainment and top-quality sporting events to Macao. We will continue to seek out interesting and relevant partnerships that will give the people of the area a chance to experience truly great entertainment and showcase Macao as a destination for sports fans and other entertainment seekers.”

The Cotai Strip™ will feature hotels operated by some of the most prestigious names in the hotel industry, including Four Seasons, Sheraton, St. Regis, Shangri-La, Traders, Hilton, Conrad, Fairmont, and Raffles. Las Vegas Sands Corp. will own and construct each of the hotels as well as operate the entertainment venues in each hotel.
